Some big changes are approaching, and we wanted to keep you informed. Please read through thoroughly, as your involvement in this transition is of great importance!

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

At Kiddieswim, we are reflective and adaptive. We want our levels to reflect trends in swimming that have changed since our last level progression shift over 10 years ago. As such, our levels will be changing our criteria at set points.

Much of the learning progression remains the same, with some key changes including:

- *Shift to a bent arm recovery in earlier levels for Freestyle*
- *Removal of S-pull for Freestyle, and Bent-arm press for Backstroke in the learn-to-swim program (refined at squad level)*
- *Shifted assessable distance of competitive strokes to 50m (from 100m)*
- *Included an endurance swim component for the highest levels (Level 9 - 200m; Level 10 - 400m)*

We will move from 6 levels to 10 levels. Level 1&2, along with Level 3&4 will be run as composite classes, with both levels in the one class. Our Squad classes will now comprise of level 9&10.

Swimmers will all be assessed against the new levels at the end of Term 2, and placed in a corresponding class. Swimmers will be placed at their existing time as a priority, or as close to this as possible.

NEW SOFTWARE

Kiddieswim will be shifting to a new software program for bookings and billing from July. The new software includes features to view class vacancies, book make-ups online, make class change requests and manage your payments.

All families will need to register and input their details for iClass Pro. *Once you are signed up and your swimmers have been assessed, we can secure your place for Term 3.*

KIDDIESWIM CALENDAR

Kiddieswim will continue offering classes throughout the year, with a shift from Term based bookings to enrolling month-by-month. The change will allow families greater flexibility if taking their own holidays or time away from swimming, while allowing others to swim when families are still around.

We will now have one week of non-program time each school holiday period to offer our holiday intensive, with regular classes continuing through the other week. We will close for 2 weeks over the Christmas period, and remain closed for all public holidays.

2026-2027 PRICING

The shift away from term based programming will be reflected in our billing cycle also. All families will be billed on a month-by-month basis, with the fees payable on the 1st day of the calendar month.

Swimmers will be charged for the number of allotted swims that month only – you never pay when we close, as it should be!

Families will need to input debit details when creating their profile, and can manage this digitally moving forward. No forms, all self managed.

This shift means we will no longer accept the following payment methods next term:

- Bank transfer
- Cash payments

Class charges will be visible the week prior to the debit run, meaning families can check their amount ahead of time and ensure funds are available, or process the transaction earlier should they choose to.

The lesson charges for 2026 – 2027 will remain set at:

- \$18 per lesson
